



## DISTRICT OF HIGHLANDS BYLAW NO. 475

### A BYLAW RESPECTING THE ENFORCEMENT OF BYLAW NOTICES

---

This bylaw is created in accordance with the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*.

The Council of the District of Highlands in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

#### 1. CITATION

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 475, 2025”.

#### 2. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw,

“**Act**” means the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*.

“**Day**” means a calendar day.

“**District**” means the District of Highlands.

“**Registry**” means the District Bylaw Notice Adjudication Registry established under this Bylaw.

“**Regulation**” means the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Regulation adopted pursuant to the *Act*.

#### 3. TERMS

The terms in this bylaw have the same meaning as the terms defined in the *Act*.

#### 4. BYLAW CONTRAVENTIONS

- a) The bylaws and bylaw contraventions designated in Schedule A attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw, may be dealt with by bylaw notice.
- b) Each day a bylaw contravention occurs or is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offence.

## **5. PENALTY**

The penalty for a contravention referred to in Section 4 is as follows:

- a) subject to sections 5. b) and 5. c), the penalty amount set out in Column 3 (Fine Amount) of Schedule A;
- b) the early payment amount set out in Column 4 (Early Payment) of Scheduled A if payment is received by the District within fourteen (14) days of the person receiving or presumed to have received the Notice; and
- c) the late payment amount set out in Column 5 (Late Payment) of Schedule A if more than twenty eight (28) days have passed since the person received or is presumed to have received the bylaw notice.

## **6. PERIOD FOR PAYING OR DISPUTING NOTICE**

- a) A person who receives a Bylaw Notice must, within fourteen (14) days of the date on which the person received or is presumed to have received the Bylaw Notice:
  - i. pay the penalty, or
  - ii. request dispute adjudication;

by filling in the appropriate portion of the Bylaw Notice indicating either a payment or a dispute and delivering it by the methods detailed on the Bylaw Notice.

- b) A person may pay the indicated penalty after fourteen (14) days of receiving or have presumed to have received the notice, subject to the applicable late payment surcharge for late payment in accordance with Section 5 c) of this bylaw, but no person may dispute the notice after fourteen (14) days of receiving or presumed to have received the Bylaw Notice.
- c) Where a person was not served personally with a bylaw notice and advises the District, in accordance with the requirements of the Act, that they did not receive a copy of the original bylaw notice, the time limits for responding to a bylaw notice under Section 5 of this bylaw begin to run from the day after the date of redelivered bylaw notice is received or presumed to have been received in accordance with the Act.

## **7. BYLAW NOTICE ADJUDICATION REGISTRY**

- a) The Registry is established as a bylaw notice dispute adjudication system in accordance with the Act to resolve disputes in relation to bylaw notices in respect of whether:
  - (i) the contravention alleged in a bylaw notice occurred as alleged; or
  - (ii) the terms and conditions of a compliance agreement were observed or performed.

- b) The civic address of the Registry is the District of Highlands, 1980 Millstream Road, Victoria BC V9B 6H1.
- c) Every person who is unsuccessful in a dispute adjudication in relation to a bylaw notice or a compliance agreement under the dispute adjudication system established under this section must pay the District an additional fee of \$25 for the purpose of the District recovering the costs of the adjudication system.

## **8. SCREENING OFFICERS**

- a) The position of Screening Officer is established.
- b) Persons acting as any of the following are designated as officers for the purpose of this bylaw and may be appointed as Screening Officers:
  - i. Chief Administrative Officer
  - ii. Corporate Officer
  - iii. Fire Chief
  - iv. Building Official
  - v. Municipal Planner

and other persons Acting in another capacity on behalf of the District for the purpose of enforcement of one or more of its bylaws.

- c) The Chief Administrative Officer may appoint Screening Officers from the classes of persons listed in Section 8 b) by name or office or otherwise.

## **9. POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF SCREENING OFFICERS**

- a) The powers, duties and functions of Screening Officers are as set out in the Act, and include the following powers:
  - i. Where requested by the person against whom a contravention is alleged, communicate information respecting the:
    - nature of the contravention;
    - provision of the bylaw contravened;
    - facts on which the contravention allegation is based;
    - penalty for a contravention;
    - opportunity enter into a compliance agreement;
    - opportunity to proceed to the bylaw notice adjudication system; and
    - fee or fees payable in relation to the bylaw notice enforcement process.
  - ii. To communicate with any or all the following for the purposes of performing their functions under this bylaw and the Act:
    - the person against whom a contravention is alleged or their

- representative;
  - the officer issuing the notice;
  - the complainant or their representative; or
  - the District's own staff and records regarding the disputant's history of bylaw compliance.
- iii. To prepare and enter into compliance agreements under the *Act* with persons who dispute bylaw notices, including to establish terms and conditions for compliance that the Screening Officer considers necessary or advisable, including time periods for payment of penalties and compliance with the bylaw.
  - iv. To provide for payment of a reduced penalty if a compliance agreement is entered into.
  - v. To cancel Bylaw Notices in accordance with the *Act* or District policies and procedures.
- b) A Screening Officer may not screen a bylaw notice which they have issued.

## **10. COMPLIANCE AGREEMENTS**

- a) A compliance agreement may not exceed a duration of one year.
- b) The maximum penalty reduction permitted under a compliance agreement is 50%.

## **11. BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**

*Persons acting as any of the following are designated as bylaw enforcement officers for the purposes of this bylaw and the Act:*

- a) Bylaw Enforcement Officer
- b) Animal Control Officer
- c) Fire Chief
- d) Deputy Fire Chief
- e) Building Official
- f) Business License Inspector
- g) Municipal Planner
- h) Chief Administrative Officer
- i) Corporate Officer
- j) Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP)

## **12. FORM OF BYLAW NOTICE**

The District may from time to time provide for the form or forms of the bylaw notice, provided the bylaw notice complies with Section 4 of the *Act*.

**13. SCHEDULES**

Schedule A (Designated Bylaw Contraventions and Penalties) is attached and forms part of this Bylaw.

**14. SEVERABILITY**

If a section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason declared invalid by a competent jurisdiction, the decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw.
